this is the story of hansel and gretel as you've never seen it before paired with the modern art style of renowned illustrator kveta pacovská the tale takes on a stunning new life for a new century the text includes the complete grimm brothers tale with all its dangers and suspenseful trickery it is a tale of survival cleverness perseverance and love

pictured worlds is a lavishly illustrated large format reference book highlighting the work of 101 top children's illustrators in pictured worlds renowned historian leonard s marcus shares his incomparable knowledge of illustrated children's books which came of age in the 18th century when john newbery set a model for tailoring books to the interests and capabilities of young readers and went on to become a global cultural phenomenon the author of more than 25 award winning books marcus here highlights an international roster of 101 artists of the past 200 years whose touchstone achievements collectively chart the major trends and turning points in the history of children's book illustration while some illustrators explored in this lively volume john tenniel maurice sendak have become household names marcus's wide ranging survey also shines a light on several lesser known figures whose unique contributions merit a closer look the result is a sweeping chronicle of a vibrant art form and cultural driver that has touched the lives of literate peoples everywhere more than 500 illustrations showcase landmark books from great britain the united states france germany austria italy sweden czech republic russia japan china korea bulgaria argentina cameroon and more each illustrated entry comprises an artist's biography and career overview and a deep dive into a pivotal book and its legacy featured books include ivan bilibin's the tale of the golden cockerel leo lionni's inch by inch richard doyle's in fairyland květa pacovská's one five many helen oxenbury's we're going on a bear hunt anno mitsumasa's anno's journey and zhu cheng liang's a new year's reunion as well as the books that introduced such iconic characters as alice max struwwelpeter the little prince and winnie the pooh at once a celebration of illustrated children's books and an essential reference work pictured worlds encapsulates in the author's words the special nature of the illustrated children's book as a cultural enterprise that is at once a rewarding art form a bridge across cultures and a ladder between generations

euphoria and dystopia the banff new media institute dialogues is a compendium of some of the most important thinking about art and technology to have taken place in the last few decades at the international level based on the research of the banff new media institute bnmi from 1995 to 2005 the book celebrates the belief that the creative sector artists and cultural industries in collaboration with scientists social

it is often assumed that picturebooks are for very young readers because of their emphasis on the illustrations and their scarcity of text however there are increasing numbers of picturebooks where the age of the implied reader is questionable these are picturebooks whose controversial subject matter and unconventional often unsettling style of illustration challenge the reader pushing them to question and probe deeper to understand what the book is about in addition to the book challenging the reader the reader often challenges the book in an attempt to understand what is being said these increasingly popular picturebooks work on many different levels they are truly polysemic and worthy of in depth analysis they push the reader to ask questions and in many instances are intrinsically philosophical often dealing with fundamental life issues challenging and controversial picturebooks examines these unconventional non conformist picturebooks considering what they are their audience and their purpose it also considers children s and adults thoughts on these kinds of picturebooks how challenging and unsettling wordless picturebooks can play with the mind and promote philosophical thought what creates non conformity and strangeness is it the illustrations and their style the subject matter or a combination of both why certain countries create promote and accept these picturebooks more than others why certain picturebooks are censored and what factors are in play when these decisions are made the role of publishers in translating and publishing these picturebooks children s creative and critical responses to strange unsettling and often disturbing visual texts this inspiring and thought provoking volume explores the work of a number of highly respected international picturebook experts and includes an exclusive interview with the legendary klaus flugge managing director of andersen press one of the few remaining independent children s book publishers in england it is an indispensable reference for all interested in or working with picturebooks including researchers students in higher and teacher education english advisors inspectors literacy consultants and classroom teachers
